It was decided that we need another flier to go out before National Night Out, August 4. Officer Baquera is the contact officer for NNO and may be able to schedule a K-9 officer and companion for NNO.

Suggestions for programs for our SVNA meetings include having a speaker from the water department to give suggestions for water wise planting and water saving methods.

Audrey Hargrave volunteered to call the few people that don't have internet to remind them of meetings. Glenda Hay will post meeting times and dates on Next Door Neighbor and the Press Tribune.

Representatives from the police department were in attendance and a gold mine of information and contact numbers. They said our neighborhood was reasonably quiet.

Speed limit signs are the responsibility of the Public Works department. City Engineering (746-1300) is the department to contact about street lights or lack thereof. The Traffic Hotline (774-5150) likes explicit information when you call. Time of day, precise location, whether pedestrians are likely to be affected, etc.

A pit bull in a yard at the corner of Manzanita and Sequoia is a concern because of incessant barking and getting loose and frightening people. Apparently Homeowner's Insurance doesn't cover certain breeds of dog, including pit bulls, so probably the owner doesn't realize their renter has a pit bull. Animal Control is the one to call from Monday thru Friday unless it is an emergency.

If you call in with a recurring complaint, request that it be put in the LOG NOTE. That way there will be a paper trail on your specific complaint in case it needs to be pursued further.

There will be new traffic units soon and there will be 2 major high profile city traffic enforcement programs. They will be on Pleasant Grove and at the Riverside/Cirby intersection.

If you check the Roseville Police Web Site, you can find information about the "COFFEE WITH A COP" at Peets Coffee in Fountains. It is held once monthly.
