Did you know?

... From November 1 to mid-January, rake leaves out to the street and the City's "Tink" machine comes and scoops them up. Be sure your pile is 1' from the curb so the tractor doesn't chip up your curb. Bagged leaves can also be put out. Check your Fall Utility Bill for details.

...that homeowners "own" land extending into the alleys? The City does not maintain or sweep these alleys, although City garbage trucks use them. The City does NOT clear the gutters. The Phone and Power companies WILL trim trees if they are reported to be a risk to phone or power lines. Please take advantage of the Fall Leaf Pick-Up program to get your alley trimmed and clear each Fall. Winter rains will back up our incredibly old underground drainage system and many streets get flooded.
